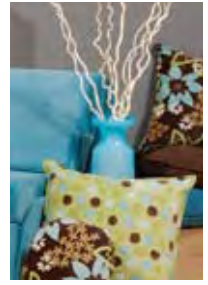


Designers say throw pillows make furniture look more inviting because they add texture and make furniture appear softer. We've compiled a few pointers from the pros to help you successfully incorporate pillows into your décor.



Throw Pillow Tips:



- 1) Consider throw pillows as the punctuation to your fabrics, use them to accent the mood in your living space.
- 2) Remember, nothing is wrong when it comes to throw pillows. Any size, any color, any combination is acceptable! The important thing is that you express your personal taste.
- 3) Be bold with throw pillows . . . it will convey confidence.
- 4) Use solid color throw pillows together with patterned throw pillows for a dramatic sophisticated design.
- 5) Use different shapes and sizes together to make your room more interesting.

Throw Pillow Myths corrected:



- ✓ You must use the same pillows on your loveseat as on your sofa.

Not true. Using different pillows adds interest, mix it up!

- ✓ It is bad form to use the same fabric on your throw pillows as on your furniture.

Not at all. This is a classic approach that adds continuity.

- ✓ You must balance pillows using the same number on either side of the sofa.

That's not so. Using a different number on either side is a technique used by designers to establish a thoughtful composition.
